



ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Anyone who would like to present their work at the EuroPerfusion conference, either as an oral or moderated poster presentation, is invited to submit an abstract for consideration by the EBCP Congress Organising Committee. Each individual may submit a maximum of two abstracts.

The scheduling of poster sessions and abstract presentations is at the discretion of the EBCP Congress Organising Committee. While submitters may indicate their preference for an oral or poster presentation, the final decision rests with the Congress Organising Committee. Every effort will be made to accommodate authors' preferences, but requests for oral presentations cannot be guaranteed.

By submitting an abstract, the presenting author formally commits to attending the conference and presenting the abstract (if accepted) as an oral or poster presentation at the assigned session and time determined by the Congress Organising Committee.

All expenses related to the preparation, submission, and presentation of an abstract are the responsibility of the presenting authors. However, one presenter of an accepted oral abstract is eligible for reimbursement of travel and hotel expenses up to a maximum of €750, upon submission of the relevant invoices via the EBCP Expense Claim Form: <https://app.twizzit.com/go/expenses>. Reimbursements will be processed after the event.

WRITING GUIDELINES

The abstract language is English.

The total length of the abstract must not exceed **300 words**.

The word count does not include references.

The abstract title should clearly define the content of the paper and should be submitted on a separate title page which should also include all authors and affiliations (see below). The body of the abstract must be structured with the following subtitles:

- **Introduction (background)**
- **Methods**
- **Results**
- **Conclusion**
- **References**

Authors: All author names should be completed in the abstract portal.

Affiliations: Each affiliation should be specified. Affiliations should include the primary employer or institution name, and location.

Since the abstracts will be judged anonymously, the abstract text may **not** reveal the institutional affiliation and/or authors.

Your study/research methodology must have been approved by local ethical committees or conform to standards currently applied in the country of origin.

The collaboration with or the support of any commercial company should be declared on the submission form and should be stated in the presentation or poster.

Please note that it is not possible to make any corrections to the submitted abstract content or information (such as presenter details, author list, etc.). To correct your abstract, you must withdraw it and submit a new corrected version prior to the deadline. Note that such replacement of the abstract is not possible after the deadline. In the case of errors in your abstract discovered after the deadline, you may indicate the correction during the presentation at the congress. However, changes will not be included in the publications. If accepted, your abstract will be published as submitted.

Permissions: It must be specified whether the work is being, or has been, submitted for publication or presentation elsewhere, and, if so, indicate how the submissions differ. Ensure that you have permission from all co-authors to submit the abstract on their behalf and to grant EBCP the license to publish the abstract if accepted.

Each abstract accepted for presentation at the EuroPerfusion conference must be presented by the nominated author in-person. The nominated presenter will be registered to attend the meeting by EBCP at no cost.

Deadline for abstract submission: 31st of May 2026.

ABSTRACT REVIEWING

All abstracts will be subject to a single blind review process by a panel of international experts in the field. Mean scores will be calculated for each abstract, based on which they will be assigned to an oral or poster presentation, or they may be rejected

There will be awards for best oral and poster presentation, based on the evaluation of the presentations during the meeting. You must be present at the meeting to accept the award.

ABSTRACT ASSIGNMENT NOTIFICATION

You will receive an notification once your abstract has been accepted or rejected by email. The date, time, and type of presentation will be confirmed at a later stage.

It is the responsibility of the submitting author to inform all co-authors of the decision.

WITHDRAWAL OF AN ABSTRACT

If you would like to withdrawal your abstract submission, this can be done via the abstract portal. Please inform San-Mari van Delft svandeventer@ebcp.eu before August 31st 2026. Failure to notify a withdrawal may result in the rejection of future submissions.

DISCLOSURE OF CONFLICT OF INTEREST

For abstracts accepted for presentation and subsequent manuscript submission, the Editor requires authors to disclose any commercial associations that may pose a conflict of interest in relation to the submitted article.

All sources of funding for the work should be acknowledged in a footnote on the title page, along with the institutional affiliations of the authors (including corporate appointments). Other associations, such as consultancies, stock ownership, other equity interests, or patent licensing arrangements, should also be disclosed during the presentation. If no conflict of interest exists, please state this clearly.

The author will be held responsible for any false statements or failure to meet the above requirements.
